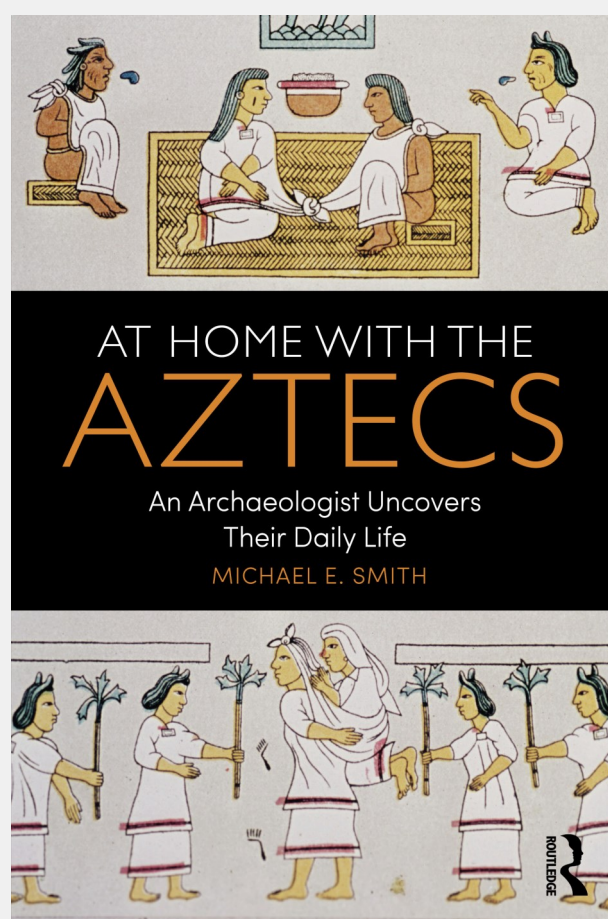

Dr. Michael E. Smith is an American archaeologist working primarily with Aztec and general Mesoamerican archaeology. He is currently Professor of Anthropology in the School of Human Evolution and Social Change at Arizona State University. He is known for stressing the importance of assessing archaeological evidence independently of the ethnohistorical sources, and advocating its use as a source of knowledge about the Aztecs and has been working along two research themes: the Aztecs and other societies in ancient central Mexico, and comparative urbanism.
