Once signed by the student and instructor, this application must be submitted either in person to the Department of Anthropology in SSC 3326, or by emailing it to: anthro-ugrad-office@uwo.ca for final approval of the Undergraduate Chair.

Application Deadline: Registration must be completed by the course registration deadlines in September and January.

Prerequisite: Registration in Year 3 or 4 of an Anthropology module, and approval from the Instructor and the Undergraduate Chair of the Department of Anthropology.

Notes:

1. Students may only add one reading course per term per year.
2. A subject or topic name will not be listed on the student's academic record. Students may wish to keep a copy of this application and course outline for future reference. It will show as follows:
