

Department of Anthropology Instructor Permission Application form for ANTH 3398B: Special Topics In Anthropology: Advanced Zooarchaeology Professor Lisa Hodgetts

Applications submitted by <u>March 10</u> will receive first consideration. Applications will continue to be considered after this date if any registration spaces remain open.

Course description:

This course will allow students to conduct original collaborative research on a faunal assemblage from an archaeological site in Ontario. Students will put into practice their bone identification and analytical skills acquired in the introductory Zooarchaeology class (ANTHRO 3310). They will participate in all stages of the research process from literature review to research design, analysis, interpretation and publication of the results. At all stages, this research will be a team effort, with students collectively determining how to divide and distribute the work. The capstone project for the course will be a co-authored manuscript that we will submit to a regional archaeology journal. The course is intended to provide students with concrete experiences and transferrable skills (team work, project management, research, writing) that will be valuable to them in pursuing graduate studies and/or in a range of work environments.

Your application will be reviewed by the Instructor and the Undergrad Chair of the Department of Anthropology. If you are approved to take the course, the Department will send the list of approved students to the Registrar's Office, and you will be added to the course at that time. If you decide not to take the course, you must drop the course through on-line Web Registration, as well as email the Instructor and the Department of Anthropology that you have dropped the course.
