

**New course running in the Winter term 2024:**

**Anthropology 3393G: Special Topics in Anthropology: Climate Risk and Justice**

Course description:

Climate change is a looming crisis that affects everyone, but the harms and benefits of climate change are not evenly distributed. This course looks at climate change as a social phenomenon and asks, how can a focus on climate justice change the way we respond to this emerging challenge? Students will learn about different theories and approaches to climate justice and use that knowledge to examine specific cases of injustice. This course will teach students to think critically about the climate crisis and its naturalization and devise new ways to respond to the challenges ahead.
