

## APPLICATION FORM Anthropology 3325F/G and 4430F/G READINGS IN ANTHROPOLOGY

The Readings & Research course is designed by a student and an Instructor of Anthropology for individual study of current interest in Anthropology.

A brief course outline is to be developed in consultation with the instructor and student and must accompany this application. The outline should include a description of the topic and a listing of the required work for evaluation such as assignments, research papers, readings, etc. The application and outline must be submitted prior to or during the ADD registration periods in September and January either in person to the Department of Anthropology room SSC 3326 or by email to <u>anthro-ugrad-office@uwo.ca</u>. Final approval is made by the Undergrad Chair and students will be notified of the decision. Registration in the course is done between the Department and the Registrar's Office in line with the ADD deadline dates.

<u>Prerequisite:</u> Registration in Year 3 or 4 of an Anthropology module, and approval from the Instructor and the Undergraduate Chair of the Department of Anthropology.

## Notes:

- 1. Students may only add one reading course per term per year.
- 2. A subject or topic name will not be listed on the student's academic record. Students may wish to keep a copy of the course outline for future reference. It will show as follows:
