Pucan's interests lie in the Cultural Intellectual Property Rights of the Anishinaabeg of North America. Pucan discovered the 1930s' wax cylinder audio collection of Robert Thompson, Elizabeth Thompson, and Dr. Edwin Seaborn. The recordings share Anishinaabeg conversations, songs, and stories and were recorded when it was illegal for the Indigenous Peoples of Canada to practice their culture and speak their language.
